

## **FOSS COTTAGE INFORMATION & GUIDELINES**

Please note that these are family cottages which are let during the weeks that we are not using them, so that other families can enjoy the very special facilities of East Prawle

### **Arrival and Departure**

Arrival: We cannot make the cottage available before 3 pm.

Departure: The cottage **MUST** be vacated by 10 am. Please leave the cottage as clean as you can - our cleaners only have time for a brief final check.

Please always leave at least 2 or 3 pound coins in the electricity meter for the next visitors.

### **Bedrooms**

Linen is not provided but the cleaners have a system whereby they provide and wash linen and even make the beds if you contact and arrange what you want, including payment, directly with them. Their email is: gfwatson@candg-cleaning.com, telephone: 01548 559 359, mobile: 07834 872641.

We mainly use duvets on the beds but there are extra blankets for winter.

**Always use under-sheets and pillowcases** even if you have sleeping bags. If you move beds around please **put them back** where they were.

#### **Front Room East overlooking the sea**

There is one double bed 5ft wide.

There is a travel cot stored in this room

#### **Front Room West also overlooking the sea**

There is one double bed 5ft wide and one single bed

#### **Small back room**

There is a single bed with a pull out bed underneath

#### **Top back room**

There is a single bed with a pull out bed underneath

### **Bathrooms**

There are two bathrooms, one with a shower attachment and one without.

### **Kitchen**

There are 2 fridges, a freezer, a modern electric stove and also a dishwasher, a washing machine and a dryer. There is also a high chair, usually kept in the back store room.

#### **Cooker**

The cooker has a ceramic hob which means it should only be cleaned with the special cleaning fluid found under the sink. Please follow instructions on the back of the cleaning fluid bottle, and for stubborn marks please use the special ceramic hob scraper which can also be found under the sink.

**Dishwasher**

In the last couple of years we have had numerous call-outs for the blocked dishwasher. Please clear plates before putting them in it.

**Dryer**

Please only turn the knob clockwise, or it breaks the dryer. Quirkily it is numbered from 100 down to 20, rather than the reverse.

**Heating**

Every room has an electric wall heater and the sitting room also has an open fire and a night storage and electric heater. Coal and logs can be bought either at the Piglet Stores or at East Charleton garage/Ashby's Easy Stores.

**Parking**

The neighbours object very strongly to any form of turning or parking in their garden. There is room to turn a single car in Foss garden but if you have more than one you will have to back out. If you can't do this, it is necessary to park on the green.

It is forbidden to climb over any of the garden fences. We have had a long legal dispute with the local farmer, resulting in an agreement not to trespass on his land.

**In emergency**
